APPEAL FOR IN-KIND DONATION FOR PAKISTAN FLOOD VICTIMS

DEAR IN-KIND DONORS: FOLLOWING LIST HAS THE PRIORITY ITEMS FOR PAKISTAN'S FLOOD VICTIMS

The relief items should not be "used items"; food items should be Halal only; medicines should have sufficient expiry date and must comply with standards/specifications of Ministry of Health and Health Regulatory Authorities of Pakistan.

These must be packed in 15 " x 15 " x 12 " cartons: To make things a little easier for us, it would be ideal, if smaller groups could get together and drop the items at this above location.

FOOD ITEMS

1. Dried Milk for Children and Families
2. Dates
3. High Nutrition Biscuits
4. Food Packets Consisting of Tea, Sugar, Milk Powder, Vegetable Oil, Pulses and Spices
5. Mineral Water

NON-FOOD ITEMS

1. Water Coolers
2. Cooking Utensils
3. Footwear (NEW)
4. Mosquito Nets
5. Blankets (NEW)
6. Bed Sheets (NEW)
7. Floor Mattresses

MEDICINES

1. Anti-Typhoid
2. Anti-Cholera
3. Anti-Malaria
4. Anti-Tetanus
5. Anti-Diarrhea
6. Anti-Snake Venom

PERSONAL HYGIENE KIT

1. Soap
2. Hand Towels
3. Tooth Paste, Tooth Brush
4. Female Sanitary Pads
5. Diapers / Pampers
6. Washing Powder / Soap

MISCELLENOUS

1. Oral Rehydration Solution
2. Mosquito Repellents
3. Prickly Heat Powder
4. Anti-Rash Cream for Children
5. Water Purification Tablets and Units
6. Candles / Match Boxes
7. Torches and Batteries
8. Shoes (NEW)

Do not send vaccines and do not engage in mass immunization campaigns before consulting with WHO.

Used clothing, shoes: do not send! In most cases, the local community donates more than enough of these items to meet the demand. It is more economical, convenient and sanitary to purchase items locally than to ship used items.

Temporary shelter such as tents, do not send them! Temporary resettlements in relative houses or in public edifices are by far more appropriate than creating population displacement camps.
